Please accept answers to your letter dated July 25, 2006. I am the president of Shaving Israel and I am empowered to speak on behalf of the organization. We have put a hold on ALL activities due to lack of a letter that tells us we qualify for an exemption.

- 1. We would like to discuss these topics in the future educational lectures:**
 - a. The need of toiletries for members of the IDF
 - b. The fact that we are an all-volunteer group.
 - c. There is no paid staff.
 - d. We have volunteers who will bear witness to what the conditions are for the lone soldier devoid of a support system.
 - e. We will disabuse any idea in our constituency of the notion that F16's equals luxury in the foxhole.
 - f. Other topics that fit our mission.

- 2. How do you make sure that the gifts given in FY2005 were used by LIBI to provide toiletries, hygienic provisions, and food for members of the IDF in need?** We received the attached accounting of how LIBI distributes our funds. Vouchers for toiletries, hygienic provisions, and food are issued in various amounts instead of cash.

- 3. How do you communicate to LIBI that you want your organizations donated funds to be used for provide toiletries, hygienic provisions, and food for members of the IDF in need?** We send an award letter (example for our first gift FY05 attached) that instructs LIBI to restrict un of our funds to such items.

- 4. In the future, how will you make sure that LIBI spends your donated funds in the charitable manner that you prescribe?** We will follow the procedure described above.
