

Reporting Procedures for Grants

## Preamble

Organization connected with Shaving Israel must be of the highest ethical standards and integrity. Accountability for our donors' gifts is of utmost importance. Shaving Israel's mission is to benefit members of the IDF. With this in mind, organizations associated with Shaving Israel must also have this as a primary goal. In addition, it must be accountable to us for funds granted by Shaving Israel.

As set forward, these procedures are intended to fulfill the principle of accountability.

## Procedures for accountability of Beneficiary

A grant letter is written with instruction regarding:

- a. How to restrict the grant
- b. The purpose of the gift
- c. From whom the gift is being given (Shaving Israel)

The need for reporting in order to hold the organization accountable

## Procedures for Grant Maker (Shaving Israel)

Shaving Israel will thoroughly investigate any organization it makes grants to determine:

- a. Its alignment with Shaving Israel's mission
- b. Its level of integrity and accountability
- c. How it determines its charitable class

A grant letter is written with instruction regarding:

- a. The amount of the gift
- b. How the transfer of money is to be accomplished

Money is taken from excess funds by board resolution. Only in extreme circumstances will money be given for purposes outside our mission. All funds must still benefit members of the IDF. In no instance can a grant be made based on anticipated revenue.
